A scholarship program administered by the West Virginia Department of Education and sponsored by various schools and institutions is offered annually to GED[®] graduates. You may qualify for a scholarship if:

1. You are a GED[®] graduate with a score of at least 250 prior to January 1, 2002 or 2500 after January 1, 2002
2. You are a resident of West Virginia
3. You have been accepted or are enrolled full-time (12 or more hours) in school
